

Tax credit from the Government

Get up to a \$200 Tax credit from the Government

The Tax Relief, Unemployment Insurance Reauthorization, and Job Creation Act of 2010 modifies and extends federal tax credits for eligible building components that improve energy efficiency. To be eligible, windows must have both a U-Factor equal to or less than 0.30 and a Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC) equal to or less than 0.30

How to qualify for the Tax Credit*

The window must have both a U-Factor and SHGC of 0.30 or lower. To qualify for the tax credit the products have to be EnergyStar® qualified.

- All Superior energy efficient vinyl windows: 1000, 2000, and 3000 series
- EnergyStar® Qualified in All 50 States
- Superior offers EnergyStar® qualified vinyl windows with Cardinal LoE366 glass, the ultimate performance glass, EnergyStar® compliant everywhere in the country.
- Purchase and install qualifying products beginning January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 and meet all other requirements outlined in the federal tax code.

Claim the tax credit associated with your qualifying purchase on your Federal filing for the 2011 tax year.



2011 Energy Tax Credit Information

Tax credit is for the cost of the product only and does not include installation costs. Be sure to ask for a sales receipt that shows the cost of the product only.

Tax credit is 10% of the amount paid for the products up to a maximum \$200.00. This is a tax credit for 2011.

Tax Credit for Energy Efficient Exterior Windows

- Installed in taxpayer's primary residence by December 31, 2011.
- 10% of purchase price (installation costs are not covered by the tax credit).
- Maximum Credit: \$200 for qualified energy efficient vinyl windows.
- New construction and rentals do not qualify for the tax credit.
- Homeowners should retain the Manufacturer's Certification Statement with their records and are not required to submit with their tax return.
- The IRS form for requesting the home improvements tax credit is IRS Form 5695
